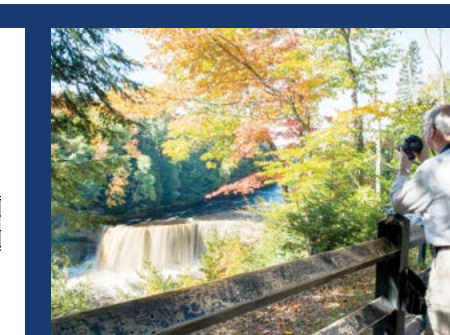

HOW TO DRIVE A ROUNDABOUT
Michigan is rolling out more roundabouts. They are easy to navigate and safer than traditional intersections. Remember, traffic in the roundabout always moves counterclockwise.

- Choose your lane before entering.
- Yield to traffic already in the roundabout and to pedestrians in crosswalks.
- Use signs and pavement markings to help guide you.
